## DAW Chair - Fiberglass

Appearing on the market for the first time in 1950, Charles and Ray Eames used innovative materials and techniques for the DAW Fiberglass Armchair that shocked the world into a new appreciation of what furniture could be. This piece was one of the first industrially manufactured reinforced plastic chairs, but more than 50 years later, the organic shape is now timeless and iconic. This realization of the design includes the high back, deep seat, and waterfall edge of the original, making the chair incredibly comfortable. The DAW Fiberglass Armchair is a premium version of the DAW Molded Plastic Armchair and is an ideal piece of contemporary furniture for the dining room or office.
